School Development Plan – Overall Goal

 Our focus this year will be on mental health and resilience, with a focus on task design and assessment and student engagement.





School Development Plan – Literacy Improvement

- When students feel safe and regulated, they can better engage in learning. We will measure student literacy using the following measures:
 - Outcome tracking
 - Course completion
 - Stream changes in Grade 11 & 12 courses
 - Diploma results
 - 3 and 5 year High School Graduation Rate
 - Student perception data







School Development Plan – Mathematics Improvement

- When students feel safe and regulated, they can better engage in learning. We will measure student success in Mathematics using the following measures:
 - Outcomes tracking
 - Course completion
 - Number of students taking diploma stream math (and science) courses
 - Diploma results
 - Student perception data







School Development Plan – Well-Being Improvement

- When students feel safe and regulated, they can better engage in learning. We will measure student well-being using the following measures:
 - Attendance (monthly)
 - Workload on completion days (# assignments outstanding prior and post)
 - Time on task (not out of class to regulate)
 - Attendance and participation on community days
 - Student perception data

Our School Budget

- Our school received \$1,690,506 in 2023-24 to provide a quality education to our students and meet the goals in our school development plan (SDP).
- At least 75 per cent of budgeted funds covers staffing and the remaining portion covers instructional and operational supplies.

Our 2023-24 School Fees

We will consult with families by outlining proposed activities for the upcoming year that may require a fee for cost recovery.

This year activities that have costs include:

- · 4 in-school community days
- 3 community field trips
- WordFest/Theatre Calgary
- Course fees for Art, Physical Education and Foods
- Grad

As in the past, most of the costs of educational programming are covered by our generous Parent Association.

This year, a portion of the cost of the Drumheller Field Trip will be the only fee charged to families. (\$40)

Graduation Fees are charged as a cost per ticket for the banquet. (\$70)


